
Raised Pet Feeder - Small

MATERIALS LIST

1 x 8 @ **16**"

1 x 3 @ 43 1/2"

2 - 16-oz. Basic Stainless Bowl from Petco quarter round (optional) @ 52 1/2"


CUT LIST

1 – 1 × 8 @ **16**" (Top)

1 - 1 x 3 @ 16" (Front Panel)


2 - 1 x 3 @ 6 1/2" (Side Panels)

1 - 1 x 3 @ 14 1/2" (Back Panel)




STEP 1

Using a jigsaw cut two 5" circles out of your top. The bowls I am using for this plan are 5 1/2" in diameter. This will give the bowls a 1/2" lip to rest on. Don't worry about your circles being perfect because the bowls will cover them.




STEP 2


(Remember to predrill all of your Kreg holes before attaching any of your pieces!) Attach your front panel to the top.



STEP 3
Attach each of your side pieces to the top and front panel.



STEP 4
Attach the back piece to the sides and top.



(Optional) Nail mitered quarter round around the bottom of the feeder.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Fill any nail holes and paint or stain as desired.
