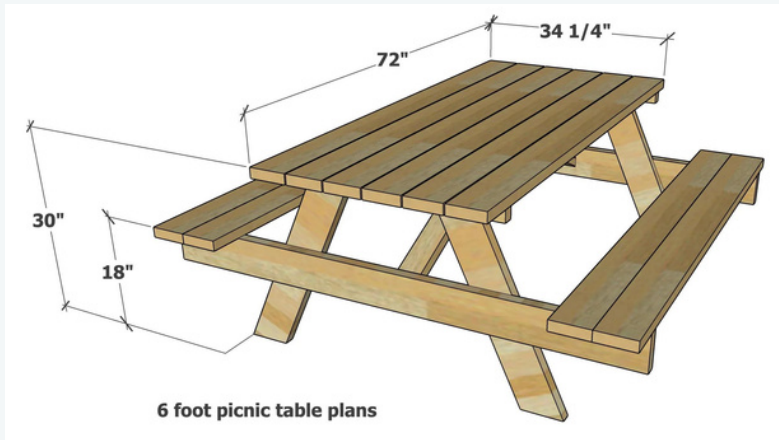

Shopping List

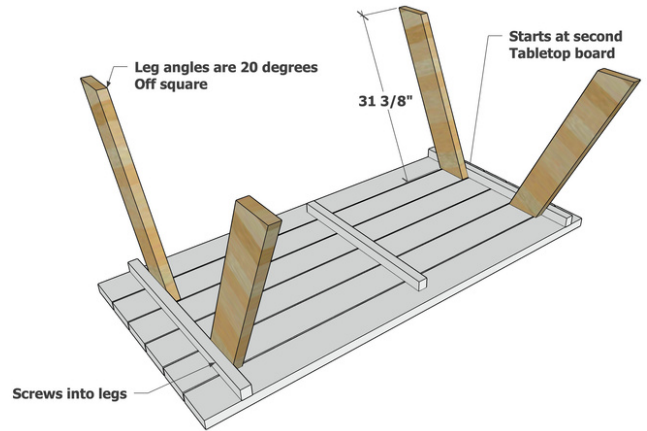
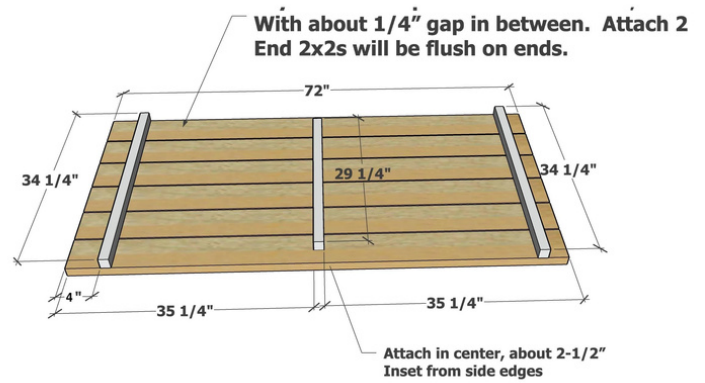
- 3 - 2x4 @ 8 feet long
- 7 - 2x6 @ 12 feet long
- 1 - 2x2 @ 8 feet long
- 100 - 2-1/2" self tapping exterior wood screws

Cut List

- 12- 2x6 @ 72" (Tabletop, Stringers, Seats)
- 2 - 2x2 @ 34-1/4" (Tabletop Supports)
- 1 - 2x2 @ 27" (Center Tabletop Support)
- 4 - 2x6 @ 31-3/8" both ends cut at 25 degrees off square, ends are parallel, long point to short point measurement (legs)
- 2 - 2x4 @ 32-7/8" both ends cut at 25 degrees off square, ends NOT parallel, long point to long point measurement (Cross Supports)
- 2 - 2x4 @ 63" (Extra Supports Under Seats)

Plan Notes

- Recommend Douglas Fir lumber
- Exterior penetrating stain
- Cut boards using a miter saw
- Sand and prefinish boards before assembly
- Use self tapping star bit screws, #9 or #10
- Work on a flat, level surface, especially important in steps 3 and 4
- Not shown: add 2x4 under the seat boards to create extra support for center of seat



Flip table over and make sure it is resting I
Attach seat support boards to legs as show
